

The MJ Biomass Gas Stove (BGS) is a second generation type stove technology that converts solid biomass wastes into gaseous fuel for domestic cooking. Gaseous flame, having a mixture of CO, H₂ and CH₄, are efficiently burned in the stove for convenient cooking while reducing CO₂ gas emission.



The stove comes into varying models and sizes to suit the availability of fuel in the locality. Biomass fuel like wood charcoal, carbonized coal, or pellets can be used in the stove.
